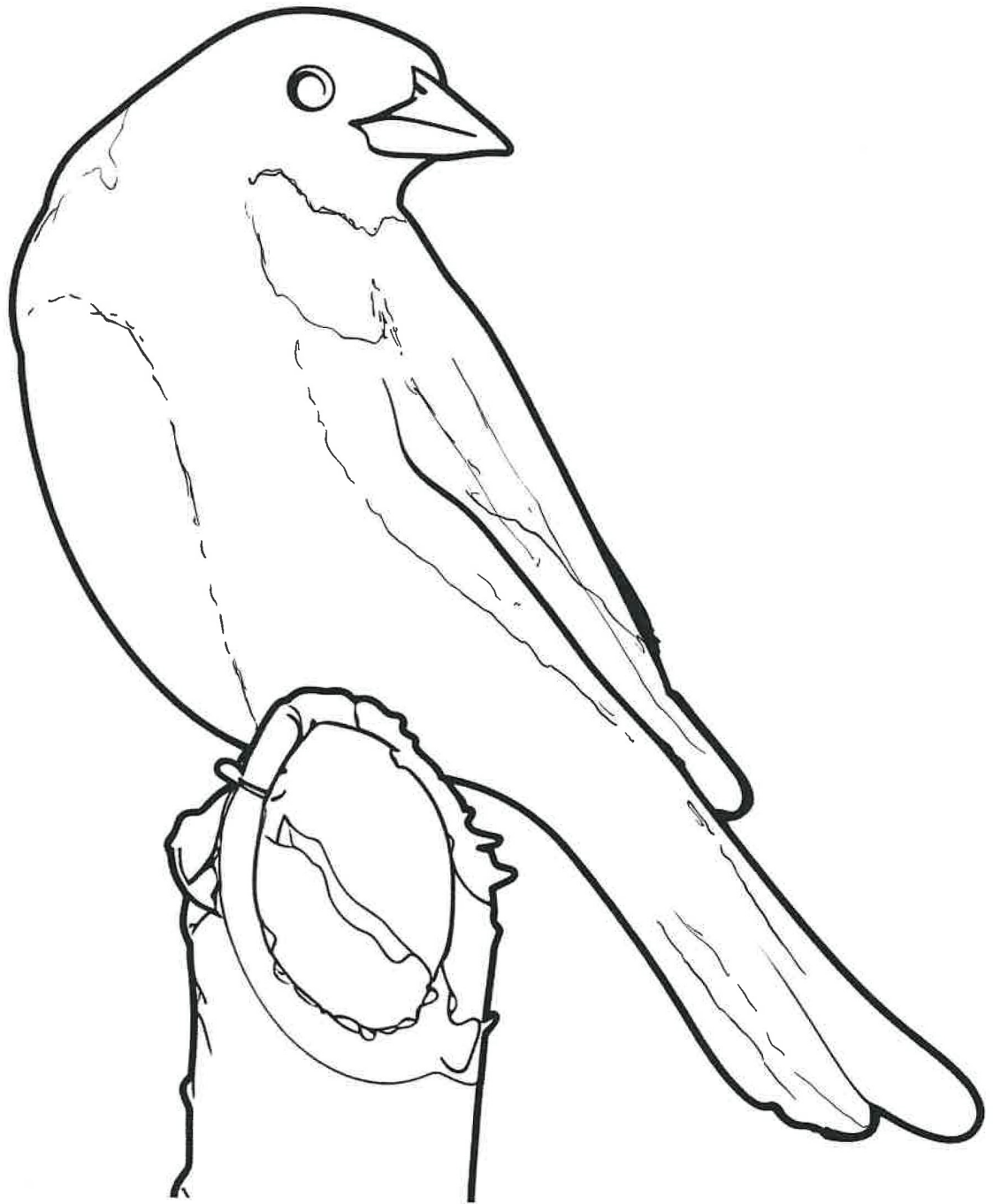

The Bahama Oriole builds a deep pouch-shaped woven nest that often hangs from the underside of palm trees and pine branches. Roughly 15-25 cm long, with a narrow entrance, it often blends in with the environment and is typically a safe place to lay her eggs.



The shiny cowbird with its bluish-black feathers is one of the main predators of the Bahama Oriole. It often lays its own eggs in the nest of the Bahama Oriole, and when hatched, kills off all of its young
